## Meeting Minutes of February 12, 2014

### Opening

President Bill Hay opened the February meeting of the Illini Free Spirit Riders Motorcycle Club at 6:02PM. Nineteen members were in attendance.

### Secretary's Report

Minutes from the January meeting were made available prior to the meeting. Bill asked the members to review the minutes. A motion was made by Lee Lasseigne to accept the minutes as submitted. The motion was seconded and a vote was taken. The minutes were unanimously accepted.

### Treasurer's Report

Treasurer Bob Crawley presented his report. Bob Siessmann motioned to accept the report. The motion was seconded and a vote was taken. The report was unanimously accepted.

### Business

#### Old Business

- 2013 Club Mileage Awards were announced and distributed. After correcting an attendance discrepancy in the Florida Here We Come Ride, the Top Mileage Award of \$100.00 went to Bill and Linda Hay for 7,751 Club Miles in 2013. Lee Lasseigne took Second Place and \$50.00 with 7,396 Club Miles and Third Place and \$25.00 went to Tim Gron for 7,394 Club Miles. "Total Bike Mileage" standings for 2013 were restated. Bill Hay (18,102 miles), Lee Grunwald (11,728 miles), Lee Lasseigne (9,326 miles), Bob Didrickson (9,140 miles) and Ron Dougherty (9,097 miles) were the top bike mileage leaders.
- President Bill Hay presented ride statistics. "Best Attended Rides", "Number of Rides Attended", "Most Mileage per Ride" and so forth were featured. Statistic sheets were distributed to those desiring a copy.

#### New Business

- In the Fox Valley Cycles' report, John Conley reported that the Honda CTX model may be in the dealership in March. John also announced plans for a 2014 FVC Bowling Party. February 23, 2014 is the date. RSVP by February 22<sup>nd</sup> and cost will be \$15.00 for bowling, pizza and pop or \$7.00 for just pizza and pop.
- The 2014 Ride Planning meeting is set for Saturday, February 15, 2014 at FVC. Meeting begins at 9:00AM. FVC will provide coffee, donuts and bagels.
